Safety Data Sheet---Non-Hazardous Animal Food Items

This certificate addresses the need for an OSHA Hazard Communication Standard Form (Safety Data Sheet) relating to our products.

Animal food and animal food ingredients/products are not considered to be hazardous under OSHA standards and are exempted from the requirement to supply SDS forms for two reasons:

1. Animal food/ animal food ingredients/products are exempted from the requirements of the OSHA Hazard Communication Standards because they are subject to the inspection and labeling requirements of the Food and Drug Administration[29CFR:1910.1200(b)(ii)].
2. These animal food ingredients/products are not classified as “hazardous chemicals” as they are not deemed to present a health or a physical hazard in regard to their handling and/or their consumption [29CFR:1910.1200(c)].

Because of these two exemptions, it is not deemed to be required or necessary for manufacturers of animal foods and animal food ingredients to provide SDS to their customers.
