


Drill with 3/16" bit 3/4" Wrench 1/4" Allen Wrench Pliers


To Set Switch Position:


Manually raise or lower curtains to desired height. Place template over side even with center of load block (as shown below at left), then follow the instructions for installation.


When installation is complete, manually raise and lower curtain past the switch slowly to be sure that the switch operates without binding.












