CLOSTRIDIUM PREBIOTIC

A clostridial prebiotic for use in turkeys.



- 1. Determine approximate age that clostridial dermatitis occurs on the farm.
- 2. Approximately 6 weeks before the expected onset of clostridial dermatitis, typically at 6-10 weeks of age, give 500 cc per 1,000 birds of product in water line in a 4-6 hour period. (No vaccine stabilizer necessary.)
- 3. Repeat the 500 cc per 1,000 birds 2-3 weeks after the initial dose (typically at 8-12 weeks of age).
- 4. Some flocks may require a third dosage in high challenge situations.
- 5. If clostridial dermatitis incidence begins, repeat with one more dose after a day or two of penicillin. The enhancing agent should allow the birds to launch a good response to any clostridium that are inactivated by penicillin. This will allow for a very specific response to clostridium sp.

Proteins derived from clostridial cultures, combined with "STIMULAR" enhancing agent.
