Overview


The Deadbolt Phone Line Surge Suppressor (Model 9820) protects your modem and other electronic equipment from transient voltages appearing on the telephone lines. It features three stages of protection: a gas discharge tube, transient voltage suppressor diodes and two easily replaced surge rated slow-acting fuses.

Installation and Wiring

Deadbolt protects your electronic equipment by redirecting damaging transient surge voltages to earth ground. A good ground connection is essential for proper operation of the Deadbolt.

For optimum protection, mount the Deadbolt as close as possible to the phone service entry point for the building. Mounting tabs are provided for easy installation.

Phone service entry panels are usually located close to the electrical service entry panel. This is generally a good place to make your ground connection. However, some panels may not be properly grounded. An alternate good ground connection would be to a long buried grounding rod. A



qualified electrician should complete any wiring inside the electrical service panel.

Connect the telephone line to the Deadbolt's INput connector, using the cable provided, and the modem to the Deadbolt's OUTput connector. If your phone service entry does not have a modular style connector, you may need to cut off one end of the provided cable. **Note:** If the tip and ring signals get reversed, your modem will not operate properly.

Operation



Press and turn counterclockwise with a screwdriver to open.

While your Deadbolt will automatically reset after redirecting a transient surge voltage, a long duration surge could also blow the internal fuses, disconnecting your equipment from the telephone lines. Blown fuses can be removed with a screwdriver by pressing in and then turning the fuse holder in a counterclockwise direction. Fuses should be replaced with a slow-acting surge rated 1.25 amp fuse rated for 250 volt operation. Two spare fuses are included and additional fuses can be purchased from Blue Earth Research. If after replacing the fuses your equipment still doesn't work, the Deadbolt may have suffered permanent damage and should be replaced.
