



3. Physical Description

The PT Controller is shown below both closed and with the door open. The major components are labled as well.





4. Use of Equipment

This unit can be used to control one PowerTrak machine or two PowerTrak machines simultaneously. The controller has an option with or without internal timer. The timer allows you to set delays for curtain movement. This unit can also be used in conjunction with a timer or a stage controller.

Warning: There are two separate circuits which are capable of running one PowerTrak or RollSeal motor each. Do not connect more than one to either circuit.

5. Installation

5.1 Tools Required

Screw Driver Drill Wire Strippers

5.2 Instructions

- 1. Mount unit to wall near power supply.
- 2. Connect power supply to controller using the wiring diagram shown in back of this manual. See Section 7.
- 3. Connect 3 wire PowerTrak to controller using the wiring diagram shown in back of this manual. See Section 8.
- 4. Various options of connections for thermostat, motors, and controllers are shown in the back of this manual.
- 5. When connections have been completed, close door and apply power.

6. Operation

6.1 Manual Control


When the *Automatic/Manual* switch is in *Manual*, the controller will open and close the curtains or vents whenever the bottom switch is in its open or close position. The center position of the switch is the off position.

6.2 Automatic Control

To place the PT Controller in automatic operation, select Automatic with the top toggle switch on the control box. The terminals (position 4, 5, 6, and 7 on the terminal strip) need to be connected before this operation will work. See wiring diagrams in the back of this manual.


6.3 Internal Timer

The internal timer is a five minute timer (see fig 1). The timer has two timer wheels, one for the close operation and one for the open operation. The two tabs on each wheel controls the duration of the close and open operation. When adjusting the tabs, the further apart the longer the operation, closer together the shorter the operation.




7. Connection of Power Supply

PT Controller




Important: Care must be taken to make sure that the appropriate voltage is connected to L1 and L2. For example, if your PT Controller is a 240VAC model make sure 240VAC is supplied.




9. Connection of RollSeal Tube Motor

This diagram is for wiring RollSeal inlets to PT Controller. This can be for control or interface with another controller.




10. Control Signals for Models with Timer

10.1 Connection of Thermostat




10.2 Connection to Stages for Control
