
Modem Installation

Installation

You can attach a modem to your controller to allow remote access from a computer. This access gives you many of the same capabilities as using the controller's keypad.

Three sets of wires must be connected to the modem:


- 1) 9V wire from the 110V power transformer that comes with the modem (or other power source 9V to 12V). The modem must be grounded. If there is no ground wire from the power supply, connect a grounding wire to the GND connection. You can attach it to a ground connection in the controller or any good electrical ground close by.
- 2) Standard telephone line hooked into the phone system.
- 3) Two-lead communications wire (22 or 24 gauge) attaching the modem output terminals to the input/output board in the controller. Shielded wire can be used to connect communication grounds between controllers, modems and other equipment.





Wiring with Multiple Controllers

The modem should be wired in a daisy chain with the controllers as shown below. The connections inside the controller are made at the Modem terminal block. Up to 16 controllers can be wired to the same modem. A maximum of 1000 ft. (300m) of communications wire can be run in any direction from the modem or interface.




If the modem is at the beginning or end of the daisy chain, you will need to set the termination switch inside the modem to ON (refer to the *Modem Termination* section). If the modem is anywhere in the middle of the chain, you will need to set the termination switch inside the modem to OFF.

Refer to your controller's *Installation Manual* for information about terminating the controller.

Wiring with a Single Controller

Connect the controller's Modem terminal block connections to the corresponding terminals inside the modem. Termination should be ON for both devices since they are each at the end of the communication chain.



Setting the Rings before Answer

You can set the number of rings the modem will wait before answering. This is done by turning switches 1 and 2 (on the modem configuration DIP switch) on or off.

Rings	DIP 1	DIP 2
1 Ring	OFF	OFF
3 Rings	OFF	ON
4 Rings	ON	OFF
5 Rings	ON	ON

Note: Switch 3 is always set to OFF.

Modem Termination

If the modem is at the beginning or end of the communications daisy chain, you will need to set the termination switch inside the modem to ON. Otherwise, termination should be OFF.

DIP 4 OFF – The modem is wired between controllers.

ON – The modem is at the beginning or end of the chain.
